

About the petition to the Agricultural Land Commission

The petition that is the final section of the Garden City Lands Coalition's request to the Agricultural Land Commission, *Save Garden City*, had 1,846 signatories at the time when *Save Garden City*, a response to the application to remove the Garden City Lands from the ALR, was submitted to the Commission.

The petition consists of:

- (a) printed sheets with handwritten signatures
- (b) online signatories from www.petitiononline.com/SaveGCL/petition.html

The petition request to the B.C. Agricultural Land Commission is as follows:

We, the undersigned, request that the Garden City Lands, Richmond, B.C., remain green in the Agricultural Land Reserve (ALR) for agricultural and ecological uses and park uses that may be permitted within the ALR.

A copy of the complete petition, with approximately* 1,846 signatories up to that time, was provided to the Agricultural Land Commission for each panel member and staff member working on the application.

*Note: The total is approximate because some factors throw the numbers off slightly:

- There are some duplications that should only count as one signatory.
- There are some places where the names of two people, who should count as two signatories, are on the same line.

Those two factors roughly cancel each other out.

There may also be a few more people signing the online petition.
